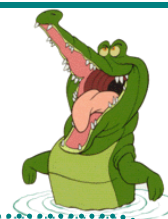



# Present Perfect Tense



 + have (haven't) + ed/d  
has (hasn't) III

(VH) have +  + ed/d  
has III

► We use the Present Perfect to describe the present result of a past action:

*I **have lost** my passport.* (I can't find my passport now)

► We often use it to talk about changes and achievements:

*She **has cut** her hair.*

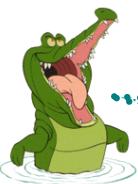
